A Star Why are famous people called stars? Famous people are called "stars" because there was a historical marketing practice that began in the 1820s and has roots in the cultural association of exceptional people with celestial bodies.

The term was first widely applied to actors to promote their tours and make them stand out as exceptional talents, much like stars are in the night sky. This association also draws from a long-standing cultural tradition that links the celestial with the exceptional human.

I enjoy the night skies of northern Ontario. The Milky Way and constellations are sights to behold. I can't name or locate most of them - I just enjoy taking it all in. One aspect of Christmas is the sighting of THE STAR and it led them to the Messiah Stars were depended on more back then.

Navigating at night was done by the stars. Where do you look when things are dark around you? There was a musical production in the 70's called Jesus Christ Superstar. Initially unable to get backing for a stage production, the composers released the score as a 1970 concept album, an immediate success which led to its Broadway stage debut in 1971. By 1980, the musical had grossed more than \$237 million worldwide.

Running over eight years in London between 1972 and 1980, the show held the record for longest-running West End musical until 1989 Jesus was not a star by today's definition - He did not earn the millions of dollars (but he does own the cattle on a thousand hills) or live in a mansion (but now sits on the throne on the right-hand of God the Father in heaven) but He was an influencer, He did get world-wide attention.

The Hollywood stars of today will eventually loose their brightness, they will die just like you and I. Their opinions are no more important than yours or mine. Let the Star guide you to Jesus - it's all about Him. He is the Brightest Star.

Building an orphanage and a protection wall for the displaced children of Liberia.

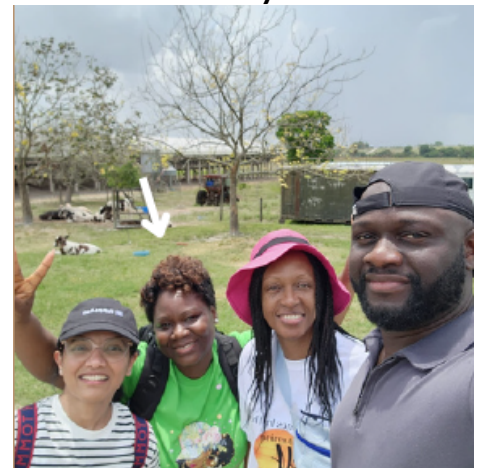
### March

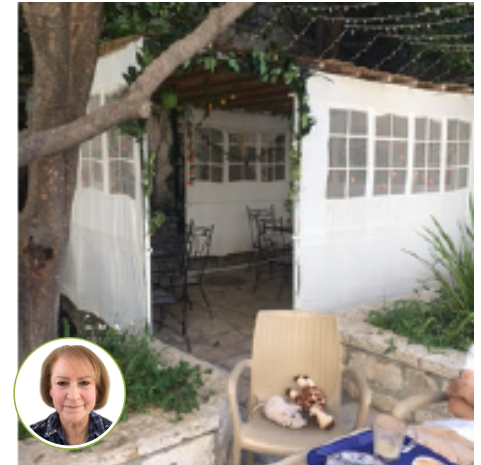

# Christian History

## GOD PROMISED GOOD THINGS TO COME.

ZECHARIAH, a priest and prophet, was born in Babylonia and returned to Jerusalem in 538 B.C. He began prophesying in the late fall of 520 B.C. and received eight visions from God on February 15, 519 B.C.

A year and a half later, the exiles who returned from Babylon and settled in the city of Bethel sent a delegation to Jerusalem, wanting to know whether they should continue to fast each summer as they had in Babylonia on the anniversary of the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem by Nebuchadnezzar.

On December 7, 518 B.C., God gave the answer to their question to Zechariah:

"Say to all your people and your priests, 'During those seventy years of exile, when you fasted and mourned in the summer and at the festival in early autumn, was it really for me that you were fasting? And even now in your holy festivals, you don't think about me but only of pleasing yourselves.

Isn't this the same message the Lord proclaimed through the prophets years ago, when Jerusalem and the towns of Judah were bustling with people, and the Negev and the foothills of Judah were populated areas?'

"This is what the Lord Almighty says: Judge fairly and honestly, and show mercy and kindness to one another. Do not oppress widows, orphans, foreigners, and poor people. And do not make evil plans to harm each other.

"Your ancestors would not listen to this message. They turned stubbornly away and put their fingers in their ears to keep from

hearing. They made their hearts as hard as stone, so they could not hear the law or the messages that the Lord Almighty had sent them by his Spirit through the earlier prophets. That is why the Lord Almighty was so angry with them.

"Since they refused to listen when I called to them, I would not listen when they called to me, says the Lord Almighty. I scattered them

as with a whirlwind among the distant nations, where they lived as strangers.

Then another message came to me from the Lord. . . . "Now the Lord says: I am returning to Mount Zion, and I will live in Jerusalem.

### **THE FUTURE OF JERUSALEM**

Then Jerusalem will be called the Faithful City; the mountain of the Lord Almighty will be called the Holy Mountain....

"All this may seem impossible to you now, a small and discouraged remnant of God's people. But do you think this is impossible for me, the Lord Almighty? . . . You can be sure that I will rescue my people from the east and from the west. I will bring them home again to live safely in Jerusalem. They will be my people, and I will be faithful and just toward them as their God." (Zechariah 7:5-8:8)

Then finally, came the specific answer to the question of the delegation from Bethel:

"This is what the Lord Almighty says: The traditional fasts and times of mourning you have kept in early summer, midsummer, autumn, and winter are now ended. They will become festivals of joy and celebration for the people of Judah. . . .

"People from nations and cities around the world will travel to Jerusalem.... People from many nations, even powerful nations, will come to Jerusalem to seek the Lord Almighty and to ask the Lord to bless them." (8:19-22)

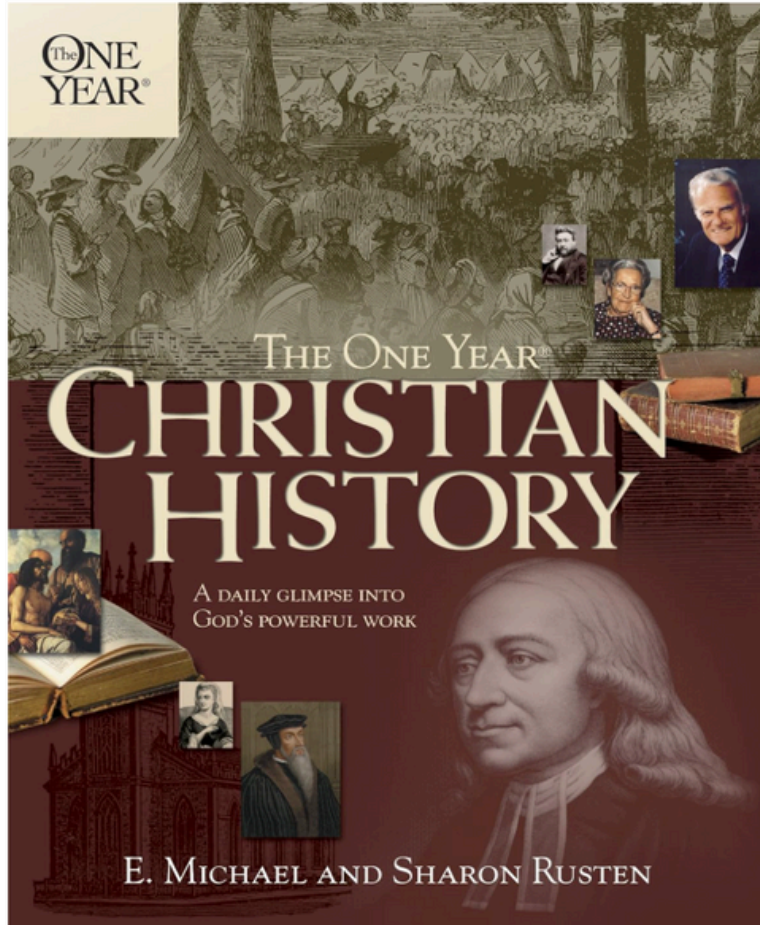
## Reflection
